WHAT IS IT?

A system that allows residents with special needs the opportunity to provide information to assist in planning to meet their needs before, during, and after emergencies.



WHO ARE THOSE WITH SPECIAL NEEDS

"Populations whose members may have additional needs before, during and after an incident in functional areas including but not limited to: maintaining independence, communication, transportation, supervision and medical care. Individuals potentially in need of additional assistance during emergencies may include those with have disabilities; those who live in institutionalized settings; the elderly and children; those from diverse cultures; those with limited English proficiency or are non-English speaking; and individuals who are transportation disadvantaged."
